History

In 2004 Police Technical LLC was established to further professionalize the law enforcement training processes created by Thomas M. Manson.

By 2007 Police Technical was recognized as a Sole Source Provider by federal law enforcement agencies, offering a level of training unavailable from any other source.

Police Technical incorporated in 2009 to provide a suitable structure to expand business operations. By 2010, Police Technical was scheduling over 50 courses a year (primarily PowerPoint® for Public Safety™) across North America.

In mid-2011, national announcements were made to develop additional Police Technical instructors to meet the deficiency of technical training among law enforcement.

By early 2012, multiple new classes were developed and being taught by additional instructors.

In the future, Police Technical will continue to develop and provide technical training to address the continuing needs of law enforcement and public safety.

Excel® for Public Safety™ - Harnessing the power of Microsoft Excel® to better manage data and improve investigations. Telephone tolls, financials, arrest stats, fugitive lists and calls for service analyzed with a few clicks.

Emerging Technologies™ - Designed to help public safety executives prepare for technological changes in the public safety workplace. Case studies are presented to assist in the deployment and management of technology.

Google for Public Safety™ - Examines how public safety can leverage Google services for operations and investigations. More than just a Search also included are YouTube, Maps, Gmail, Google Voice, Drive and Apps.

Online Investigations™ - Designed to assist personnel become more proficient in online criminal investigations, an emphasis is placed on social media and proactive undercover investigations. Students will create UC online profiles, and deploy them using techniques learned in class.

PowerPoint® for Public Safety™ - Designed to assist all personnel become more efficient and proficient with PowerPoint® software, from basic design to case management; custom animation, video, audio, and Splash Screens®.

Social Media Methods™ Designed to help departments and their personnel utilize social media effectively to manage their online presence; Designed to assist personnel in PIO, investigations and community relations position.

Tablets and Smartphones for Public Safety - Designed to assist agencies properly select, plan, deploy and utilize tablets and smartphones. Discussion includes various platforms and devices, best practices, and insight for current and future smart device purchases.

Word and Adobe for Public Safety - Designed to help personnel create, manage, share and protect public safety documentation. Emphasis is placed on creating agency specific branded themes, shareable templates, and custom reports.

Process and Costs

We offer the class in 2 ways:

In-Service

In this option the course is typically purchased by a single agency (or collection of agencies) to provide training to their personnel. Two days of training is provided in the subject area, taught by an expert instructor trained in POLICE TECHNICAL teaching methodologies.

Training materials (manuals, online downloadable course materials, and certificates of completion) are provided for up to 40 students.

Two Day Course (Standard)

Cost includes all fees (travel, lodging, instructor fees, and insurance): **\$6500.00**

Three Day Course (Standard 2 Day course with additional day of hands-on exercises/materials)

Most POLICE TECHNICAL courses have the ability to add a 3rd day of hands-on activity to the standard course.

Cost includes all fees (travel, lodging, instructor fees, and insurance): **\$9000.00**

Discounts for multiple classes are granted.

Open Registration

In this option POLICE TECHNICAL partners with a host agency. The host agency provides the training facility and marketing (email, print, etc) to support of the class. In exchange the host receives 2 free seats when POLICE TECHNICAL obtains 10 paying registrations and an additional 2 free seats (for a total 4) when 20 paying registrations are submitted. Each 2 day class is \$350.00 per person. POLICE TECHNICAL averages 20-30 in a class but must have 15 registered personnel to successfully run the class.

POLICE TECHNICAL asks host agencies to commit to hosting 2 or more of classes within a 12 month window. Agencies that are familiar with the process of open registration classes (provided marketing for support previous classes to surrounding departments, room set up needs, etc) are given scheduling priority.

Requirements: A modern classroom with seating for 40 or more (a computer lab is **not necessary**, personnel will bring their own laptops) and an open wireless internet access (for instructor and students).

Training materials (manuals, online downloadable course materials, and certificates of completion) are provided for all attending students.

Two Day Course (Standard)

Cost includes all fees (travel, lodging, instructor fees, insurance): **No cost**

Three Day Courses are not offered as Open Registration.
